2010 CHS International Fair

The 2010 CHS International Fair will be held on March 12, 2010. Following are some important details:

- *Set up the fair on Thursday, March 11, 1:30 - 3:30 in the gym.
- *Fair opens at 8:30 on March 12 for the judges. A 1st, 2nd, 3rd place award will be given.
- *Fair opens for everyone 3rd period - 6th period.
- *Countries dismantled during 7th period on the 12th.

The gym will have tables and chairs set up for your booths. You will be responsible for providing your own extension cords and such. As of November 23, we have 22 countries represented. In the past, the countries have been set up according to the teacher (all of Mr. Roach's countries will be together, All of Mrs. Helm's etc.). We may try something new this year and that is to set them up according to which continent the country is in. That is still under debate. However, regardless of how they are set up, each country will receive a number. That will be how they are identified on the judges' score sheet.

Remember: You are creating a "mini country". Be creative, artistic, detailed, etc. Use music, games, food, clothes, etc. You want to make the judges (and all who visit the fair) feel like they are in that country and make them want to visit your country. You want to give them insight about that particular country that they may not normally have.

Students and/or faculty need to be manning the booths for the entire day, so you will want to set up a schedule for this. ALSO and VERY IMPORTANT: Students need to be manning the booths during the judging of the countries because the judges will ask questions to see how thoroughly they researched their country. **Proquest's Culturegrams** will be a VERY good place to go for information. **Proquest** is found on the media center Website and the **username and password may be obtained from Mrs. Jordan in the media center.**

We have received permission from Mr. Smith to open the concession stand during the fair. I am hopeful that Mrs. Watt will be manning it again this year.

FOOD IN THE FAIR: It will be perfectly alright for you to have food for display purposes in the gym, but NOT for students to eat. If you want to prepare ethnic food for students to eat, individually wrap it and give it to Mrs. Watt to sell in concessions. Your class will be able to get the proceeds for this. All other food sold in the concession stand (normal concessions) will go to the media center.
